Assessment Task:	Sweep (steer) and control a Dragon Boat for Training and Racing.		
Purpose of Assessment:	This assessment task will enable the sweep to demonstrate competency in the steering and control of a Dragon Boat to gain level 2 accreditation as a sweep		
Assessment Conditions	The sweep will: a. have access to a dragon boat at a recognised dragon boating venue b. supply a crew of at least 18 persons (drummer is not required) c. be permitted to re-present for assessment as many times as necessary in order to achieve competency.		
Evidence Required:	 a. The sweep is required to provide a logbook detailing dates and a minimum of 20 hours sweep training. b. The sweep is required to demonstrate all of the assessment criteria as set out in the checklist below. c. The sweep must demonstrate the assessment criteria consistently throughout the assessment.

1	Load boat ensuring safety rules observed and boat is correctly balanced (number off, balance method)					
2	Demonstrate effective control of the boat using recognised instructions (dig it in, hold drift, paddles on etc)					
3	Reverse the boat into a race start - hold position in preparation for race start (use paddlers to draw and position boat)					
4	Call Race Start and steer boat in straight line for 500 metres under full power (using correct calls)					
5	Manoeuvre boat in a tight turn of no more than 60 metres diameter keeping line and maintaining control					
7	Utilise clear, concise and confident instructions to crew at all times					
1	Return boat to shore and utilise correct unloading procedures
