CCWC Qualification 2020 (France)

AusDBF has considered the feedback received following the recent Australian Championships held at Kawana, Queensland.

Successful completion of all three (3) distances – 200m, 500m and 2000m – are counted towards qualifications for CCWC.

Currently each country is allowed to sanction five (5) standard boats and two (2) small boats per racing class at CCWC. However, it is at the discretion of IDBF to change this number at any time. Any changes to this ratio may affect the number of crews sanctioned by AusDBF to participate.

The qualifications for Premier and Juniors days were able to be run in 2018 without any significant challenges to all 3 race distances, therefore qualification invitations will be awarded to the applicable crews. AusDBF will be writing to the successful clubs (3 in standard boat and 1 in small boat) in the coming week.

The clubs will have 30 days from receipt of letter to confirm their acceptance of the qualification. All qualifications not accepted will be made available at the 2019 Australian Championships.

With regards to the two (2) Senior days of racing in 2018, due to the challenging weather conditions and only being able to run one (1) complete distance (200m), all qualifications for Mixed, Open and Women across standard and small boats for Senior A, B and C will be awarded at the 2019 Australian Championships.

Should the 2019 Australian Championships be subjected to challenging weather conditions affecting qualifications, the following selection methods will be applied in order, i.e. the ideal method is listed as #1, if that fails, the next method implemented will be #2, and so on.

1. All qualifications across all three distances in 2019 (ideal situation).
2. If one distance is affected by weather, then qualifications will be based on the two successful distance results from 2019.
3. If two distances are affected by weather, then qualifications will be based on the one successful distance from 2019 and the 200m results from 2018.
4. If all three distances are washed out, then results will be taken from only the 200m results from the 2018 Australian Championships.
