1	The Chair welcomed attendees, noting that all States were represented in person except			
2	DBWA who furnished a proxy, and opened the meeting at 11:10am.  Special resolution 1:			
	'That the Australian Dragon Boat Federation Constitution 2016 be adopted effective mmediately and replacing the previous Constitution."			
3	Special resolution 2: That under clause 5.3(a), the 'First Member States' at the adoption of the Australian Dragor Boat Federation Constitution 2016 do not include the Northern Territory.			
	In response to queries about the state of dragon boating in Northern Territory, the meeting noted that DBNT has been suspended until such time as they are able to demonstrate they are capable of representing the clubs and paddlers in NT as per AusDBF guidelines. At this stage, of the three clubs that comprised DBNT membership, one has joined DBWA, and the other two are considering their options. It was confirmed that where any of the three clubs become members of another State, they will be subject to the rules of that new state.  Voting results as follows: Resolution #1 – 100% unanimous support – passed.			
4	Resolution #2 - 75% affirmative achieved - passed.  A vote of thanks was moved for Melissa's work on the Roadshow visits/meetings.
