CCWC Qualification Holding Deposit

22 May 2018

This policy will appear as Annex 3 to Part 1– in the AusDBF Competition Rules and Regulations (Edition 7) when it is released at the end of 2018.

Within 30 days of AusChamps being completed, AusDBF will write to the successful clubs confirming their qualifications to participate in IDBF Club Crew World Championships.

Upon receipt of notification, clubs will have 30 days to reply to AusDBF to accept or decline their awarded qualification.

After qualification has been accepted, AusDBF will invoice the club \$500+gst per qualification which will act as a non-refundable security deposit. The \$500 will be put towards the entry fee to compete.

Should clubs withdraw their qualification, the \$500 per qualification will be non-refundable.

To keep the qualification, clubs are required to enter that category (if it is offered) in the subsequent championship/s prior to the CCWC. Should the club not enter the qualification, AusDBF reserves the right to rescind the qualification.

It is the clubs responsibility to ensure they comply with IDBF Competition Regulations (Racing Class – CR2.1) and (Bona fide members CR4.3). As an AusDBF sanctioned club any changes to qualifications must be approved by AusDBF.
