
To access the AusDBF Learning Management System (LMS) please logon via a laptop or desktop device. Please do not use an iPhone, iPad, or a mobile phone as they do not display all the LMS features & functionality. This is not unique to the AusDBF LMS but consistence across all sporting and health learning management systems.

Also please use the goggle chrome browser. (GOOGLE is the best browser option. Do not use Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari, etc as some of the LMS features & functionality will not be available. This can also apply to mobile phones and other browsers).






Double Click on Create new account.




Enter details for all fields.

- Once all above completed click on the Create my new account button






If you scroll down, it displays a description of all the AusDBF courses available.

From the list on right side of screen please click on the course that you need to complete.






At bottom of screen, it displays Self enrolment (Student). Underneath this is there is a Enrol me button highlighted in blue background.


If you scroll down, it displays a list of the modules within the course you have selected with a description of the content of each module.

Under this you will see the Module title highlighted in blue. This example is Cultivating Diversity, Inclusion, & Belonging for Dragon Boat Activities.






If you wish to increase the size of the main course details click on the left arrow as highlighted above.

If you wish to return the menu panel, click on the right arrow as highlighted below.





Please click on Start course button.




AusDBF eLearning modules have been designed to include text, graphics, interactive activities, videos etc or any combination of these.

Most modules have one or multiple videos included. Please take the time to view the videos as it will assist you answering questions in the final quiz assessment.

Each lesson has been setup so that you cannot continue in the flow until you have completed various activities or viewed a video etc. It will guide you thru these scenarios. If you cannot continue it means you still need to complete an activity. The text box at bottom of screen will display a message regarding what you need to do for current activity as highlighted below.




As you complete the activities, you will see a Continue button as highlighted below.

Please click on this message and it will take you to the start of the next lesson.


Please continue thru and complete each lesson.

Please navigate thru the quiz questions. It you select an incorrect answer it will display the correct answer. If you have not achieved the preset pass percentage, you will be required to start the quiz again and repeat until preset pass percentage is achieved.


At the end of each attempt of the quiz it will display the percentage you scored with the quiz pass percentage on the right as below. If you have achieved the preset pass percentage it will display a tick as below. A X will appear if pass percentage not achieved.

Please then read the instructions at bottom of screen. This scenario displays Lesson 9 – Conclusion.




This flow then displays the conclusion screen.


Please read screen information and then click on the Exit activity button as highlighted below.

You can now commence the next module for this course.


To return to the course modules please click on the Course menu option as highlighted above.

Please remember to logout when you have finished.


The next time you logon it will default to the My Courses screen and display as below.
