| Purpose | The purpose of the AusChamps Review Committee (ARC) is to make recommendations to AusDBF for consideration with regards to the format and structure of Aus Champs. |
| Objectives | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To ensure AusChamps remain the number one (1) priority for all paddlers in Australia to participate in. • To ensure AusChamps remains relevant and fresh • To ensure there is maximum participation across all age divisions and categories • To work closely with the Competition and Technical Committee to ensure recommendations align with Competition Rules and Regulations. |
| Accountability | The ARC will report directly to the AusDBF Board |
| Structure | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ARC will ideally consist of one (1) representative from each member State nominated by the State member • The ARC will also include one AusDBF Director. If this Director's term expires, the AusDBF Board will elect a new Director to the ARC • The term of each appointment is for two (2) years. If a member resigns within the two (2) year period, the State member will nominate a replacement for the remainder of the term • Appointments to the ARC will be made on a staggered basis, i.e. half appointed in the even year, half appointed in the off year • In the interests of succession planning, each Committee member will serve a maximum of 3 terms (6 years) • A member must be reappointed by their State member after their two year term, if they wish to continue. |
| Chair for Committee | The ARC will, at its first meeting, elect one of its members to the position of Chairperson. This choice must be endorsed by the AusDBF Board. |
| Meetings and Quorum | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A minimum of two meetings will be held each year. One of these meetings could be a face to face meeting held during the Australian Championships. Other meetings will be held via zoom/teleconference as required • Minutes including action items, decisions and recommendations must be taken and submitted to the AusDBF Board within 14 days of the meeting • A quorum will consist of 50% plus one of the committee members • A resolution may be passed by a simple majority of Committee members present and entitled to vote on that resolution. |
| Authority | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ARC is not authorised to make any decisions or communicate directly with members. All recommendations are to be forwarded to AusDBF Board for consideration • Any communication requiring input from members or member States must be approved and distributed by the AusDBF Board. |
