

Draft race draw released	Week beginning Monday 12 th February
Comments on draft race draw due	Friday 16 th February
Final race draw released	Monday 19 th February
Crew lists (do not need to be submitted when finalising team entries)	Must be submitted to Race Administration by 5.00pm the night prior to race day.

Emergency steerers

Emergency steerers may be available should your steerer have an accident or become ill during the competition and unable to steer. Applications must be made in writing by the team manager as soon as an emergency steerer is required. Applications must be addressed to the Chief Official and include details for which race an emergency steerer is required - an explanation of the situation, name of steerer who has become incapacitated, club and contact details. Emergency steerers will be allocated based on their availability. Teams will not be allowed to select a preferred emergency steerer. AusDBF gives no guarantee that an emergency steerer will be provided.

Training boat bookings – how to register

Boats will be available for training on Saturday 3 March 2018, 8.00am – 2.00pm.

Each booking will cover 60 minutes (from the start of loading to completion of unloading) for each Club or State Crew. There are 12 boats available for each time slot. Scheduling preference will be given to interstate crews. To book a time slot email <u>info@dbq.com.au</u> by no later than Sunday 18 Feb 2018, with your preferred time and one other in case your preferred time isn't available.

Crews will initially be allocated only one time slot. Depending on availability, there may be an opportunity to book a second slot closer to the date.

The Stadium canteen will be open during training times.

These will be held each morning at 7am outside the finish tower to go through any issues or changes.

Celebration Gatherings

This year the celebration gatherings will be held directly after racing finishes at the ground floor of Sunshine Coast Stadium (across the road from the race venue) on **Tuesday 6 March and Thursday 8 March from 4 pm – 7 pm**

- An entry of \$10.00 per person will apply (wrist band will be given on entry at the main gate)
- No pre purchase of tickets is required
- Live Entertainment will be provided
- Food will be available for purchase

Qualification for the 2020 Club Crew World Championships (CCWC)

The AusDBF Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing set out the requirements for qualification to compete at the biennial Club Crew World Championships. AusDBF is permitted to send up to five crews in the standard class in each racing category and two crews in the small boat class in each racing category.

20's Crews Qualifications

Two years prior to the CCWC the top three crews in each racing category across all distances are given first right of refusal for the CCWC qualifying spots. The top three crews are ascertained via the addition of points for each position obtained in each racing distance. In order for clubs to confirm their CCWC spot, clubs must confirm their acceptance in writing to AusDBF. The club will be required to compete at the following year's AusDBF Australian Championships in the categories they are intending to compete at the CWCC.

In the year prior to the CCWC qualifications will be based on the top club crews (that have not already accepted the positions) across all racing distances, for a particular racing category, to fill the remaining positions (maximum 5) which were not taken up by clubs the previous year.

10's Crews Qualifications

Two years prior to the CCWC the top crew in each racing category across all distances is given first right of refusal for the CCWC qualifying spot. The top crew is ascertained via the addition of points for each position obtained in each racing distance.

In order for clubs to confirm their CCWC spot, they must confirm their acceptance of categories in writing to AusDBF. The club will be required to compete at the following year's AusDBF Australian Championships in the categories they are intending to compete in the CWCC.

In the year prior to the CCWC, remaining position/s not already accepted by clubs will be offered to the top qualifying clubs.

AusDBF is required to endorse to IDBF all the clubs who have qualified in 10's and 20's across all Categories and Divisions. It is the clubs' responsibility to ensure that their Competitors fully satisfy all IDBF Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing.

Clubs who qualify are still required to attend the AusChamps in the following year to retain their qualification.

Official Photographer

Action in Focus Photography is the official photographer for the upcoming Australian Championships and it will be our 3rd Aus Champs coverage.

We are letting each State Association know that we will be offering a USB deal that will cover all images of your state competition as well as an "official" team photograph with border and logos. The images on the USB are all high resolution and can be used for marketing, promo, websites, or passed on to your team members to make digital copies or prints.

Individual images in either low medium or high resolution digital or print copies can be purchased directly from our website but the USB deal is by far the cheapest way for your team to purchase images. One high resolution image is \$35 on the website but you will get the USB containing all images taken of your state team competing plus the team photo for \$135.

If any individual would like a copy of the USB we will supply for \$25. These can be mailed to individual addresses. Prints of team photos would be \$12 ea or \$10 if more than 10 are purchased.
