Background

The AusDBF Board wishes to extend membership on its Competition and Technical Committee (C&TC). It is crucial that AusDBF has a pool of highly experienced and knowledgeable members for this important committee. As a risk management strategy two new members from the paddling community are being sought through an expression of interest (EOI) process.

The purpose of the AusDBF C&TC is to make recommendations to the AusDBF Board for consideration regarding the AusDBF Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing. The C&TC reports directly to the AusDBF Board. Meetings are held face to face once per year at the Australian Championships and, at other times as required, via zoom/teleconference.

What is needed on the C&TC?

The C&TC needs to be composed of a judicious mix of individuals from across the Australian Dragon Boating community who bring a range of perspectives to the C&TC. This 'mix' should include people who have:

- excellent knowledge of the AusDBF Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing, and of their relationship with the IDBF rules
- experience in Dragon Boating at a national and international level
- a demonstrated capacity to assess the impact of rules on enhancing participation and competition in the sport
- an interest in and the capacity to promote the work of the C&TC

If you would like to be considered for selection on the C&TC committee, please fill in the EOI form attached and return to info@ausdbf.com.au by 16 April 2020. It is important that you address each of the criteria named in the EOI form.

The selection of new members to the C&TC will be made by the AusDBF Board. The term of each appointment is for two years, up to a maximum of three terms unless approval has been granted by the AusDBF Board to extend the individual's term.
