The Historical Committee members will be in touch if they haven't already as they gather lots of information and photos to be included.

The coffee table will predominantly feature information on AusChamps and each Member State, but so that the clubs don't miss out, the Historical Committee has worked with revSPORT to create a historical site page on the club's website. Clubs will be able to go in and record their own club history with links attached to the online commemorative book. If your club does not have a website powered by revSPORT, then please forward the information through for inclusion.

For clubs to set up their history page they will need to:

1. Log on to your clubs revSPORT (website)
2. Go to Site (left hand side) >
3. Go to the bottom of the list and click on History to edit History Page
4. Within the content box type in and answer these questions:
  - a. Year club was created and/or incorporated
  - b. Incorporated club name
  - c. Committee members (per each club AGM)
  - d. Club location (training venue)
  - e. Club achievements – awards
  - f. Life Members of Club
  - g. List of AusChamps, International events attended and results
  - h. Other
5. Click Save content at bottom of page
