The Historical Committee, C&TC, ROMP all met prior to the end of the of the year with numerous activities and projects being worked on. AusDBF is encouraging all their sub-committees to meet regularly to keep the

development and projects within each of the committees moving forward. Over the next 6 months AusDBF will be creating a new Sub-Committee – Athletes Commission, once the Charter has been finalized and developed, AusDBF will be seeking support from the Member States to nominate a representative to be part of the sub-committee.

revSPORT

AusDBF will continue to work closely with revSPORT to ensure there is a unified process being implemented which will benefit all the Member States and AusDBF and help to improve efficiency with collection of information and data.

AusDBF Corporate Collateral

You may have noticed the 'new look' corporate collateral being used by AusDBF in the way of letterheads, memos, policies, signatures, business cards, PowerPoint. AusDBF would like to thank Barb Clarkson for all her work and patience on creating the new suite of collateral.

AusDBF branding and logo

AusDBF has been receiving numerous emails and queries from clubs around Australia who are going through the process of ordering new race uniforms for AusChamps or CCWC later in the year. AusDBF is currently updating their Branding Guidelines, and an update will be distributed to all Member States when finalized. However AusDBF can confirm the following logos must be included on Club race shirts as was agreed several years ago when the AusDBF logo was created and implemented:

- Club logo must appear on the right frontside
- State logo must appear on the left frontside
- AusDBF logo must appear on sleeve or back of the race tops.

In exciting news prior to the end of the year, the AusDBF and Auroras logo have now been officially approved and trademarked for the next 10 years. AusDBF sees this a positive step forward to protect the logos being used without permission.

Pillar 2 – Development

The Development section of the AusDBF website has been updated with a number of new items. As a temporary solution AusDBF previously had copies of the AusDBF National Coaching Database posted under Development/Coaching Courses on website. These copies have now been removed as they were only republished every two months and were out of date with the volume of coaches completing their initial accreditation or undergoing reaccreditation.

The entire AusDBF National Coaching Database is now being loaded into the Accreditation module within RevSport and all new and reaccreditations are being entered directly into RevSport. The complete load should be finalised by beginning of February. Coaches will now be able to view their accreditation and expiry dates via their RevSport profile.

Continuing education is an ongoing requirement for AusDBF coaches of all levels. To assist in this process AusDBF has begun creating online eLearning packages that will be available for coaches to complete as part of their reaccreditation requirements and / or prerequisites to enrol in the new Level 2 and above coaching courses. Once all the eLearning packages and the reconfigured Level 2 coaching course is available we will circulate the commencement of and the requirements to enrol.

This document contains a list of online courses that can be completed and used as evidence for coaches reaccreditation continuing education requirements. It should be noted that the PBTR courses listed at 12 – 15 in above document will now be a requirement for coaches undertaking the reaccreditation process. The PBTR courses plus several new AusDBF eLearning packages will also be a prerequisite for all current Level 1 coaches who wish to enrol in the forthcoming Level 2 course.

The document at <u>1 AusDBF Coaching Accreditation Continuing Education Online modules</u> is a dynamic document and if you have undertaken or are aware of additional continuing education courses that would be relevant to AusDBF coaches please forward details to <u>development@ausdbf.com.au</u> and we will review and include in this document if relevant.

Please don't wait until the details of the new Level 2 AusDBF Coaching course are announced. You can be completing the courses that are available in above document.

- There are still Individuals who are still hitting the 'REGISTER' button in revSPORT rather than 'RENEW' in revSPORT which is creating multiple profiles which need to be regularly merged. In addition the same person has profiles under 'Deb' / 'Debbie' / 'Deborah' for example which have had to be merged. This is all coming to light because of the upload of accreditations and trying to ensure the accreditations are assigned to the correct individual.

2020 AusChamps

- Due to operational costs at SIRC, AusDBF has switched the race programs for Senior racing days 1 and 2 around, which means day 1 is now 200m and days 2 will be 2km (mixed) and 500m. Day 2 is going to be a massive day and to ensure all races are run will require the cooperation of competitors and race officials to comply with the competition rules.

At this stage AusDBF is waiting to receive an invite to attend the 4th World Cup to be held in Monaco during the European summer of 2021. Due to the political unrest around the world all events are 'watch this space' as IDBF assesses the risk and viability moving forward.

- Provisional entries for CCWC in France have now closed with all clubs attending having paid their deposits to the French Organisers.
